RULES & REGULATIONS

TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP

It is a condition of membership that each Fellow recognises and agrees to the following:

- 1. To live in peace with all Fellows.
- 2. To respect the beliefs of all Fellows.
- 3. To be tolerant of the limitations ands failings of all Fellows.
- 4. To avoid imposing personal beliefs & doctrines upon other Fellows.
- 5. To shun private piques and quarrels with all fellows.
- 6. To foster goodwill within the Fellowship.
- 7. Not to give any teaching or instruction in the name of or on behalf of the Fellowship.

MEETINGS

- 1. Attend all lectures, seminars, discussions and workshops of the Fellowship.
- 2. Seek to arrive in good time for lectures, seminars, discussions and workshops.
- 3. Abstain from alcohol, tobacco and other drugs, medication apart, whilst attending Fellowship events.
- 4. Allow lecturers to speak without interruption.
- 5. To respect the rights of all Fellows in discussions to finish speaking without interruption.

CONSTITUTION & GOVERNMENT

- The Fellowship of Dionysis & Paul is a non-profit making organisation whose purpose is the preservation and dissemination of the Western Mystery Tradition.
- 2. The Constitution of the Fellowship is hierarchic and not elective, its government being vested in the Order of Dionysis & Paul.
- 3. The decision to appoint and terminate membership rests solely with the Preceptor of the Fellowship of Dionysis & Paul.

THE FELLOWSHIP OF DIONYSIS & PAUL

The Fellowship of Dionysis & Paul is dedicated to the preservation of the ancient science of spiritual regeneration otherwise known as the Western Mystical Tradition. For more than two thousand years this Tradition has been transmitted in secret within the religious traditions of Graeco-Roman and Judaeo-Christian civilisation. It is an ancient and living tradition whose goal has ever been the spiritual regeneration of humanity.

The purpose of the Fellowship is to make available to those truly interested in the Western Mysteries, as described above, a facility and focal point wherein they may acquire a basic introduction to the essential disciplines of this traditional and ancient path of spiritual development. Over the course of two years a series of seminars, lectures, discussions and workshops, devoted to specific aspects of the disciplines involved, will give members of the Fellowship an insight to the Western Mysteries and what traditionally would be expected of an 'Initiate'.

The Fellowship is open to all who, seeking more than intellectual knowledge, may wish to develop a greater understanding of the Tradition. There are no initiations, oaths or grades of advancement, simply the sharing of knowledge in fraternity and goodwill. Furthermore, there is no joining fee to the Fellowship, although members will be expected to share the costs of seminars and associated events; the details of which will be supplied well in advance.

CURRICULUM

The following subjects will be covered by a series of one day seminars.

KABBALAH

An introduction to one of the main repositories of the spiritual wisdom of the ancient world.

MEDITATION

An introduction to the theory and practice of meditation; exploring and discussing both Eastern and Western thought and practices concerning this essential discipline.

PRAYER

An introduction to a little understood subject that on one level is a natural expression of the soul's need to commune with its maker, and on another is the heart of a sacred science of spiritual development barely known beyond the quiet waters of the contemplative.

RITUAL

An introduction to the formal dramatisation of prayer, through which the spiritual dynamics of the soul are exercised and developed.

THE LIBERAL ARTS & SCIENCES

An introduction to the esoteric interpretation of the Liberal Arts – Grammar, Logic and Rhetoric, and the Sciences – Arithmetic, Geometry, Music and Astronomy, that traditionally constituted the basis of classical education.

COMPARATIVE RELIGION

An introduction to the different religious belief systems of the world; exploring their differences and their similarities.

PHILOSOPHY & MYTHOLOGY

An introduction to the legacy of ideas, concepts and symbols bequeathed to us by our ancestors.

Spiritual Hierarchies

An introduction to the spiritual realms and the beings who inhabit them

DIVINATION

An introduction to the different aspects of divination that may be used in the development of the intuitive faculty.

HEALING

An introduction to some of the different methods and techniques of healing, with the emphasis resting upon the use of Nature's finer forces.

SACRED ART

An introduction to the use of images and symbols in the Great Work

THE AURA

An introduction to the principles and dynamics of the Sphere of Sensation; commonly known as the Aura.

ETHEREAL & ASTRAL BODIES

An introduction to some of the mysteries concerning these little understood vehicles of expression.

PRE-EXISTENCE & POSTHUMOUS EXISTENCE

An introduction to the teachings that humanity has been given concerning existence before and after life .
